Noncompeting Application

- Submitted every year to re-establish budget and strategic plan, due in March and applies to the whole next year, needs input from members to make it successful
- Capacity building and misuse prevention using data from the CLYDE Survey
- Objective- double youth participation in SFC- by June we want 5-10 youth members
- Meghan would talk to them separately and/or have only 1 student in the meeting because the meeting is in the middle of the school day

How can we get participation?

- Pizza party in middle school clubs, do something at the beginning of the year inside or outside of school, boys and girls club, pre-prom presentation Amanda Mohler, Girl/Boy Scout, Religious groups (Krista) middle school student union, middle school does not have wellness clubs
- Adam has majority K-5 but has a few 7th and 8th grade
- Youth Ambassador to SFC, application process, reference to college, community service hours, missing a class or part of the day is an incentive, important to have a mix of middle and high school
- Ann Linder is trying to enforce kids being in class/coming to school, Ashley suggested you must have good attendance/good standing as part of the application
- The students aren't going to feel included if they aren't attending the meetings themselves, we can give them the schedule far in advance, The youth portion is at the beginning of the meeting and then they leave
